General Statement of Duties

Performs routine manual work in the collection of garbage, trash and yard waste in the Sanitation Section of the Public Works Division.

Distinguishing Features of the Class

Employees in this class perform manual labor involving the collection of refuse and garbage. Employee loads trash, including furniture, appliances and yard waste from curbside and collection commercial garbage. Work requires that the employee be able to perform heavy manual work continuously over an extended period of time in varying and hostile weather conditions. Work is also subject to OSHA standards on bloodborne pathogens. Work is performed under immediate supervision and is evaluated through observation and inspection to determine the thoroughness in carrying out assigned duties.

Duties and Responsibilities

Works as a member of a trash, yard waste or garbage collection crew to load trash, debris and junked furniture and appliances from roadsides.

Cleans area around cans and picks up loose trash.

Assists with dumping solid waste at transfer site or landfill.

Assists with cleaning and maintenance of trucks and tools.

Watches out for the safety of co-workers.

May operate non-CDL required vehicles as needed.

Performs related duties as required.

Recruitment and Selection Guidelines

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Some knowledge of the occupational hazards of working in traffic and with garbage and refuse.

Some knowledge of basic computer skills

Ability to perform continuous heavy manual work at a steady pace and under various and hostile weather conditions.

Ability to work cooperatively as a team member and respond courteously to citizens.

Ability to understand and follow specific oral instructions.

Ability to complete simple records.

Physical Requirements

Must be able to physically perform the basic life operational functions of climbing, balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, crawling, reaching, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, grasping, talking, hearing, feeling and repetitive motions.

Must be able to perform heavy work exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 20 pounds of force constantly to move objects.

Must possess visual acuity to operate a sanitation collection vehicle and to collect garbage and refuse.

Possession of a valid NC Driver's License
