

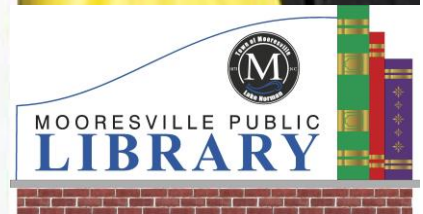

What is Teens Give Back (TGB)?

- A library program that provides teens with an opportunity to contribute and get involved with the Mooresville Public Library
- TGB is not affiliated with Town Hall or the Town of Mooresville's Volunteer Program
- Teens age 13-15 can receive credit for school requirements for volunteering at the library
- If a participant is 16 or older, they need to go through the Town of Mooresville's volunteer application in addition to the Teens Give Back application.

Why I Should Join

- Opportunity to give back to the community
- Learn new proficiencies
- Interact with library staff and the public
- Builds responsibility and leadership skills
- Provides a great reference
- Shows a love of books and libraries

What do I have to do to participate in Teens Give Back?

- All teens must sign an application form that is signed by a parent/guardian (**Applications are available at the Adult Reference desk or on the library's teen webpage**)
- Attend a scheduled training session (by appointment)
- Commit to a minimum of 15 hours per session
- Arrive on scheduled day and be on time
- Follow the directions of all MPL staff members

What kinds of things will I be doing if I sign up for Teens Give Back?

Tasks may include:

- Shelving and straightening books
- Cutting paper
- Cleaning outside areas of the library
- Assisting in library programs
- Other project duties as needs arise

When is the next training session?

- After filling out an application the Teen/YA staff member will contact you to set up a scheduled training session
